

PARKING

There is not a spot for everyone all the time in our parking lot. We do however provide a parking permit for every person that lives at Old Farm that has a car. We try to be fair in our dealings with the parking lot but it requires a lot of cooperation from all of you. Your parking permit will be revoked if there are excessive offenses.

There is a church parking lot west of our complex (see map) that will allow you to park in their lot during the day ONLY. Please follow the signs posted.

- The parking lot will be patrolled 24/7 throughout the school year. Booting will begin after Labor Day weekend and will continue until finals week in May.
- Only one parking permit is allowed per person, and you must be a current Old Farm tenant to get one.
- Come to the office with your license plate number to obtain your permit.
- You must be parked in a clearly marked parking stall.
- Double parking is allowed if you can't find a spot, but only between the hours of 11pm-8am.
- Double parking needs to be on the side closest to the Buildings (Yellow Areas).
- Whenever possible double park behind people that you know and leave your information in the window so that you can be contacted to move if needed.
- If your car is blocked, call the office with the permit number of the car that is blocking you and we will contact them.
- Driving or parking on the sidewalk is prohibited.
- DO NOT block the dumpsters at any time.
- Please park scooters and motorcycles in the designated spots on the north side of the parking lot.
